FISHING RULES

- 1. The fishing rules of the SFSA shall apply unless amended below**
- 2. Fishing will be with rod, reel and line provided for Light Line Championships – the line will be 12 lb**
- 3. Competitors must supply a sample of line in use if and when requested by the Fishing Skipper**
- 4. LIGHT LINE ONLY – Only one single hook may be used – a treble counts as three hooks**
- 5. Competitors are reminded that the length of any leader or, and double line must not exceed 6.0 metres**
- 6. N.O.S.S.A.C. ONLY – Fishing will be with the Angler's own line, and 2 hooks may be used**
- 7. PIRKING – Pirks may be fitted with a treble hook and 1 flyer**
- 8. Only underhand casting allowed**
- 9. If a fish is hooked by more than one Angler, the Angler with the hook in the mouth of the fish can count the fish, if both in body, the fish is not eligible to count**
- 10. Shark and common skate are not eligible**
- 11. Rods may not be rested on any part of the boat while playing a fish**
- 12. Competitors may only receive the assistance of others to net a fish**
- 13. All fish to be returned alive with the exception of fish an Angler wants to be weighed for the biggest fish or best specimen**
- 14. NO LIMITS ON COD/LING /POLLOCK - A MAXIMUM OF 10 OTHER FISH CAN COUNT**
- 15. NO COALFISH / MACKEREL/ SANDEEL ALLOWED.**
- 16. POINTS WILL BE FISH LENGTH TOTALS + NUMBER OF FISH + SPECIES X 2**
