COD CHAMPIONSHIPS ARBROATH 2008

The Headquarters for the Championships will be the Cliffburn Hotel, Cliffburn Road, Arbroath. (see map below)

REGISTRATION will be in the Hotel Restaurant from 8.00pm until around 10.00pm on Friday evening. There will be a further period between 0745 and 0845 hrs on Saturday morning at the harbour. Teams of Two (EFSA members only) and teams of Four (open) can be formed at registration and entries for the Sweep and Super Pool will be accepted.

At registration you will be given a note of which boat group you are in each day and a copy of the local rules which relate mainly to the scoring system and will contain no surprises for our regular Cod Championship competitors. (1 point per centimetre over the minimum length of **36 centimetres**)

FISHING

Boats will depart at 0900hrs.

Fishing will be from 0900 to 1500hrs on both days.

PRIZEGIVING

We plan to begin the prize giving by 5.15pm and, to sustain you while the results are being prepared, there will be a buffet available from 4.30pm

In addition to the usual boat winners and skippers prizes and, of course, the overall winner there is:- the **SWEEP** (too good to miss - it could be you!...)

The payout on the Sweep will be 50% for the longest Cod on Saturday and 50% for the longest on Sunday and,

the **SUPER POOL**

The Super Pool will be paid as follows:-

50% to the greatest total length of fish over the two days

30% to the 2nd greatest total length of fish over the two days

20% to the 3rd greatest total length of fish over the two days

REMEMBER

- Bait is NOT being provided BUT only Ragworm (not White Rag), Lugworm and Mussels are allowed
- This is an EFSA competition and only two hooks are allowed (a treble counts as 1 hook unbaited)
