Amendment to Rules

Please note that the Rules as printed in the Championship brochure are amended as follows.

General Rule 18 amended to read:

“Conger Eels, Rays and Tope will be released at the side of the boat. The trace must be touched by hand for the fish to count. The trace constitutes the line attached directly to the hook. This applies to the Boat Championship only. In the Line Class Championship, the leader/trace must be touched by hand for Tope and Eels only to count”

Line Class Championship Rule 8 amended to read:

“In the interests of conservation, all Conger Eels and Tope will have their weight estimated by the Boat skipper. Their decision shall be final. All other listed species must be landed for measurement”
